4. Describe the work conditions.

**Occupation 2:**

1. What are the personal requirements for workers in the occupation?

2. List the related industries and the sectors in those industries?

3. List the related courses available in your state or territory?

4. What qualifications are available and appropriate to people considering this occupation?

5. List three interesting facts you discovered in Further Information?

6. Is there any specific state and territory information you would need to be aware of, if considering this occupation?
