

Learning Experience 2

Getting that job quiz

The purpose of this learning experience is to encourage individuals or groups to explore different job search tools and techniques.

Ask individuals to brainstorm the various ways they would go about looking for a job.

Refer participants to myQuiz. The Getting that job quiz explores the underpinning principles of effective job search and provides individuals with the opportunity to test their knowledge and understanding of a variety of job search strategies.

Working in pairs or small groups ask students to access myfuture for further information about effective job searching.

The Facts > Work and Employment > Get that Job > Get a job—young people.

Once they have completed their research, ask groups to report back on what they learned about looking for work, and discuss as a class.

- What did they learn about looking for a job?
- What can they do to create a an effective job search strategy?

Ask individuals to start a job search action plan. They should identify three things they will do to get started.

Ask them to identify:

- What they are going to do. This should be an action or a task they are going to complete.
- When they will do it.
- Follow up action or the next step.
