

## Learning Experience 3

### Exploring Occupations

The purpose of this learning experience is to assist individuals or groups to develop an understanding of how they can use myfuture to explore a range of components associated with the occupations they are interested in.

#### Exploring and comparing occupations.

Ask individuals to work individually to brainstorm a list of occupations they would like to explore further. From their list, ask them to select two occupations of particular interest and conduct a comparison.

Listed below are suggested questions for individuals to research and consider.

Individuals should access information available from **myfuture > The Facts > Work and Employment > Occupations**.

- Which of the duties and tasks for this occupation appeal to you?
- Look up the personal requirements for both of the occupations you have selected. Do the occupations require similar qualities or are there significant differences?
- List any other related jobs for this occupation? Do any of these related jobs interest you?
- What are the employment opportunities in this occupation?
- What are the training / educational pathways in your state / territory for this occupation?
- How could you use this information to further explore career options?
- Make a list of further questions you have.
